In 2024, the WA Training Awards will celebrate an important milestone – its 30th anniversary. Help us celebrate the long history of the awards program, recognise excellence in the vocational education and training (VET) sector and applaud the incredible VET ambassadors this program has identified over the last 30 years.

The WA Training Awards puts the spotlight on excellence in VET and the outstanding achievements of our students, apprentices and trainees, practitioners and training providers, organisations and employers across the State. The Awards have eight individual categories, and five organisation categories.

In addition to the recognition and opportunities these prestigious awards bring, winners in individual categories will receive \$3,000.

Organisation winners are recognised as industry leaders and promoted and celebrated as such through a variety of media and marketing opportunities.

Winners of selected categories* may have the opportunity to represent WA and be acknowledged nationally at the Australian Training Awards (ATAs). State winners attend the ATAs finalists' week and presentation ceremony, where the national winners for each category are announced.
